Week 2 Exodus 2:1-25

1. What does the name "Moses" mean?
2. Where did Moses go after killing the Egyptian?
3. What did God remember when the people cried out to Him because of their slavery?

Week 3 Exodus 3:1-22

1. According to verses 5-6, what did Moses do when he met God at the burning bush?
2. God had many names, which tell us about Him. Which name does He tell Moses in this passage?
3. According to verses 19 and 20, when will Pharaoh let God's people go?

Week 4 Exodus 4:1-31

1. What did God turn Moses' staff and the water into?
2. Who returned to Egypt with Moses?
3. Moses was afraid that the people would not believe. Did they believe him?

Week 5 Review (Pick One)

1. Draw a picture showing one of the events that Moses was part of from the chapters you have read this week.
2. Write a brief summary of what you learned from the Bible this week.

Week 6 Exodus 5:1-23

1. What did Moses and Aaron ask Pharaoh?
2. After refusing to let them go, what did Pharaoh make the Israelites do?
3. Who did the people blame when they were forced to work even harder?

Week 7 Exodus 6:1-13, 28 – 7:13

1. God responds to the people's lack of faith in verses 1-8. What is one thing that He says to Moses?
2. Did the people listen to what God (through Moses) told them?
3. How old were Moses and Aaron when they spoke to Pharaoh?

Week 8 Exodus 7:14 – 8:19

1. What happened during the first plague?
2. What happened during the second plague?
3. What happened during the third plague?

Week 9 Exodus 8:20 – 9:12

1. What happened during the fourth plague?
2. What happened during the fifth plague?
3. What happened during the sixth plague?

1. Draw a picture about one of the six plagues you have learned about so far.

Week 11 **Exodus 9:13 – 10:20**

1. What happened in Egypt during the seventh plague?

1. What happened in Egypt during the ninth plague?
2. What happened where the people of Israel lived during the ninth plague?
3. What was going to happen during the tenth plague?

Week 13 **Exodus 12:1-28**

1. What did God tell a man from each household to get?
2. What did God tell His people to do with the blood from the lamb?
3. Who does the lamb foreshadow?

Week 14 **Exodus 12:29-51**

1. What happened in Egypt at midnight?
2. What were some things that the Egyptians gave to the Israelites as they left Egypt?
3. How long were the people of Israel in Egypt before God brought them out?

Week 15 **Review (Pick One)**

1. Draw a picture that shows what the people of Israel did during the first Passover.
2. Write a brief summary of what you learned from the Bible this week.

Week 16 **Exodus 14:1-31**

1. What did Pharaoh say after the people of Israel had left Egypt?
2. How did the sea part so the people of Israel could pass through?
3. What happened when the waters of the Red Sea returned to their normal place?

Week 17 **Exodus 15:1-27**

1. Did Moses take credit for leading the people across the Red Sea? If not, to whom did he give credit?
2. What does Moses say about God in verses 6, 11 and 13?
3. After Moses praised God for all He had done, what did the Israelites complain about?

Week 18 **Exodus 16:1-35**

1. What did God send to His people each morning?
2. What did God send to His people each evening?
3. How long were the Israelites fed by God in this way?

Week 19 **Exodus 19:1-25**

1. In what form is God going to appear to the people?
2. What surrounded Mount Sinai when the Lord came to speak to the people?
3. What warning did God give to the people gathered around the mountain?

Week 20 **Review (Pick One)**

1. Draw a picture showing what happened at the end of the miracle of the Red Sea crossing.
2. Write a brief summary of what you learned from the Bible this week.

Week 21 **Exodus 20:1-11**

1. What is the first commandment?
2. What does God do for those who love Him and keep His commandments?
3. How did God give us an example of resting on the seventh day?

Week 22 **Exodus 20:12-24**

1. What are some ways in which you have disobeyed the 5th commandment?
2. How did the people respond after God finished giving Moses the Ten Commandments?
3. Which commandment does God repeat in verse 23?

Week 23 **Exodus 23:1-33**

1. Find at least one law in verses 1-9 that you have broken. What is it and how did you sin against God?
2. What 3 feasts does God command the people to observe each year?
3. If the people obey, what does God promise to do for them?

Week 24 **Exodus 24:1-18**

1. What did the people say in response to God's rules?
2. What did Moses sacrifice to the Lord?
3. How did the glory of the Lord appear on the mountain?

Week 25 **Review (Pick One)**

1. Draw a picture of the Ten Commandments (two stone tablets with a brief version of each commandment written on them).
2. Write a brief summary of what you learned from the Bible this week.

Week 26 **Exodus 32:1-35**

1. What did the people do instead of having faith and patience?
2. What did Moses do after he went back down the mountain?
3. What did Aaron do instead of accepting responsibility?

Week 27 **Exodus 33:1-23**

1. What did God promise His people?
2. What warning did God give His people?
3. What did Moses see when God passed by?

Week 28 **Leviticus 9:1 – 10:7**

1. What was the purpose of the sin offering?
2. What did the fire of the Lord do to the burnt offering?
3. What happened to Nadab and Abihu?

Week 29 **Leviticus 16:1-34**

1. What was to be done with each of the two goats?
2. According to verses 16 and 30, what was the purpose of the atonement?
3. How often was this atonement made for the people?

Week 30 **Review (Pick One)**

1. Draw what you think it may have looked like when the glory of God passed by Moses.
2. Write a brief summary of what you learned from the Bible this week.

Week 31 **Leviticus 17:1-16, 19:1-10**

1. What law is given against someone who sacrifices to false gods?
2. According to verses 11 and 14, why did God command the people to not eat blood?
3. What does God say about holiness in Leviticus 19:2?

Week 32 **Leviticus 19:11-37**

1. What command is given in verse 12?
2. What do verses 15-18 tell you about how to treat other people?
3. What does verse 32 say about respecting those who are older and wiser?

Week 33 **Leviticus 20:1-27**

1. What do verses 6 and 27 say about people who try to find out what will happen in the future through fortune-tellers and other similar people?
2. What does God tell His people in verses 8 and 9?
3. According to verse 26, why should God's people act in a way that is different from other people?

Week 34 **Leviticus 26:1-26**

1. If the people obey, what does God promise them in verse 4?
2. What does God remind His people about in verse 13?
3. If the people disobey, what does God promise to do in verse 16?

Week 35 **Review (Pick One)**

1. Based on the passages from this week, list 2 commands that God gave His people, 2 things He promised to do for them if they obeyed, and 2 things He said He would do to them if they disobeyed.
2. Draw a picture of what you learned from the Bible this week.

Week 36 **Leviticus 26:27-46**

1. If the people continue to disobey, what does God promise to do in verse 33?
2. When the Israelites have been taken away, what will enjoy rest?
3. If the people finally turn from their sin after God's discipline, what does He promise in verses 42 and 45?

Week 37 **Numbers 11:1-35**

1. What did God's people complain about in verses 4-6?
2. According to verse 1, what was God's first response to the people's lack of thankfulness for all He had done for them?
3. What further consequence did God give to those who complained (verses 18-20 and 31-33)?

Week 38 **Numbers 13:1-33**

1. How many people were sent to check out the land?
2. According to verse 27, what did these men say about the land?
3. According to verse 28 and 31, what did most of them say about the people in the land?

Week 39**Numbers 20:1-29**

1. In verses 2-5, how do the people again display a lack of faith in God?
2. How did the king of Edom respond to Israel's request to pass through their land?
3. Why did Aaron die at this time?

Week 40**Review (Pick One)**

1. Draw two pictures: one picture of the land as viewed by most of the men who went to check it out, and a second picture of the land as viewed by Joshua and Caleb through eyes of faith and trust in God.
2. Write a brief summary of what you learned from the Bible this week.

1. When the people complained yet again, what consequence did they receive from God?
2. What did the people have to do in order to live?
3. How did the king of the Amorites respond to Israel's request to pass through their land?

Week 42**Numbers 22:1-41**

1. In verse 5, what did Balak the king ask Balaam to do to the people of Israel?
2. Describe how well Balaam obeyed God based on verses 13 and 18.
3. What unusual thing did God do to get Balaam's attention?

Week 43**Numbers 23:1-30**

1. When Balak told Balaam to curse Israel, what did Balaam do instead?
2. What does verse 8 tell us about the power of God?
3. What 2 truths about God does Balaam state in verse 19?

Week 44**Numbers 24:1-25**

1. In verses 5-7, what did Balaam say about Israel?
2. In verse 10, how did Balak respond when Balaam obeyed God instead of him?
3. In verse 13, how did Balaam recognize that God has power and authority over that of men?
